AKT funds a new septic tank

When we have a Trustee in Tanzania we take the opportunity for face to face discussions with the Director of SAO. This time we agreed to provide an additional septic tank on the Lakitatu site. This means that the students attending Lakitatu Secondary school can live near the school in supervised accommodation.



The process started with a single worker digging a huge hole four metres deep (see photo). Then huge piles of sand, stones, metal rods, cement and boulders arrived. The tank was constructed by a team of four within a week.
